Phantom Premium Nano Ceramic Film offers the ultimate solution in heat rejection, blocking more than 99% of the UV rays and over 99% of the infrared heat, protecting you and your passengers, while also prolonging the life of your vehicle's interior, we need you to follow some simple curing and aftercare techniques.

UNDERSTANDING THE CURING PROCESS

Your Phantom Nano Ceramic film was installed by certified tinters. The curing process in the context of window film refers to the time it takes for the adhesive on the film to fully set and bond with the surface of the window. Proper curing is essential for the film to adhere securely and function as intended. Here are the general steps you should consider:

Allow cure time. Leave Window Closed for 5-7 days

Tinted windows require time to cure and fully adhere to the glass. The curing time can vary depending on the type of tint and environmental conditions. It typically ranges from a few days to a couple of weeks.

After tinting your windows, it's normal to experience certain side effects during the initial period. Here are some common side effects and what you can expect:

Hazing or Cloudiness:

It's common for newly tinted windows to appear hazy or cloudy immediately after installation. This is often due to the moisture trapped between the film and the glass during the application process. The haze typically dissipates as the tint cures.

Bubbles:

Small water or air bubbles may be visible initially. They are often a result of the installation process and should diminish as the tint cures. Proper installation techniques, including smoothing out bubbles during application, can minimize this issue.

Water Streaks:

Water streaks or spots may be present on the tinted windows immediately after installation. This is usually a byproduct of the application process, and these streaks typically disappear as the tint dries and cures.

This is a natural side-effect of the installation process. All of these will go away as the film cures. Do not push or move any water that is trapped in between the glass and the film.

CURING



Step 1

Avoid using ammonia-based cleaners, as they can damage the tint film. Instead, opt for a mild, non-ammonia-based window cleaner. You can also make your own cleaning solution by mixing water and a small amount of mild dish soap.

Step 2

Use a soft microfiber cloth or a sponge to clean the tinted surface. This helps prevent scratches or damage to the film. Avoid using abrasive materials like paper towels or rough sponges.

Step 3

Pay special attention to the edges of the tint. Gently clean these areas to ensure no dirt or grime accumulates along the edges, which could potentially lift the tint.

Step 4

After cleaning, pat the tinted windows dry with a clean, soft cloth. This helps prevent water spots.

Step 5

Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents on the tinted windows, as they can damage the film. Stick to mild, non-abrasive cleaners.

Step 6

Regularly clean your tinted windows to prevent the buildup of dirt and grime. This will help maintain the appearance and longevity of the tint.

Step 7

Be cautious with objects that may scratch the tint. When rolling down or up the windows, ensure there are no abrasive materials on the glass or the window seals.

Key Tips On What To Avoid

- Avoid using harsh chemicals, ammonia-based cleaners, or abrasive materials when cleaning tinted windows. Stick to mild, non-ammonia-based cleaners and soft microfiber cloths to prevent damage.
- Be cautious with any sharp objects, such as keys or hard-bristled brushes, near the tinted windows. Scratches can compromise the integrity of the tint.
- When using seatbelts, be careful not to let the metal buckle hit or scratch against the tinted windows, especially during the initial curing period.
- Prevent dog claws or anything sharp rubbing on the inside of the window.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY INFORMATION

1.1 Warranty Coverage:

Phantom Nano Ceramic Film PH warrants their window film against adhesive failure, bubbling, cracking/crazing, delamination, peeling, and other manufacturer's defects. The warranty is valid if the product is properly sold and installed on suitable automobile glass surfaces by an authorized dealer following recommended installation procedures. Exclusions and conditions not covered by the warranty are detailed in Section 6, emphasizing compliance with guidelines and authorized installation for warranty validity.

1.2 Additional Warranty for Certain Products:

Phantom Film Ph provides warranty coverage for its products against excessive or unusual color change throughout the applicable warranty period.

1.3 Covered Persons/Companies:

This warranty is exclusive to independent window film dealers who bought the product from Phantom or Phantom distributor, the registered owner of the automobile at the time of installation, It is the sole and exclusive warranty provided by Phantom Film Ph for the described individuals/entities and the purchased products.

1.4 Warranty Period:

The window film is covered by a 10 Years warranty, offering protection against adhesive failure, bubbling, cracking/crazing, delamination, peeling, and other manufacturer's defects. Coverage starts from the date of installation.

1.5 Not Covered by Warranty:

This warranty becomes void, and Phantom Film Ph disclaims liability for any loss, damage, expense, or cost arising from the following:

1. Installation of the Product (whether or not (i) performed by dealer; or (ii) the installer is "Certified" by Phantom Film Ph); or
2. Improper product care, maintenance, or cleaning; or
3. Product abuse; or
4. Glass breakage; or
5. Non-automotive applications and/or non-complying film uses; or
6. Any other acts, occurrences, defects, faults or damages not caused by Phantom Film Ph.

THIS WARRANTY ONLY APPLIES TO PRODUCT INSTALLED IN PHILIPPINES

The product must be used in compliance with all relevant laws, rules, and regulations, including tinted window laws, in the applicable country, state, province, or local jurisdiction.

1.6 Limitations:

This limited warranty from Phantom Film PH is the sole and exclusive warranty for the purchased product. It replaces all other express or implied warranties and agreements, including those implied by law such as the warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

In case of any defect or failure in the product, or if it does not perform as expected, Phantom Film Ph sole obligation is to provide a replacement product and cover the cost of replacement labor. This is subject to certain limitations outlined in the warranty. If the same product is unavailable, Phantom Film Ph may, at its discretion, replace it with a similar product.

Phantom Film Ph shall not be liable for any additional costs, attorney's fees, expenses, losses, or damages, regardless of their nature (direct, special, consequential, or incidental), that are related to the product or any failure of the product to perform as represented or expected. This limitation applies regardless of the legal basis for the claim, including contract, warranty, negligence, strict products liability, tort, or any other legal theory.

Phantom Film Ph explicitly disclaims liability for any warranty, loss, or damage beyond what is expressly stated in this limited warranty. Additionally, Phantom Film Ph is not responsible for any losses or damages associated with or resulting from glass breakage.

Phantom Film Ph will furnish replacement film and cover reasonable labor charges, with a cap set at the total of the Product price and installation cost mentioned in the original invoice. If only a portion of the window film requires replacement, the labor payment will be proportionate to the defective film replaced and the installation cost specified in the original invoice.

Phantom Film Ph overall liability, encompassing breaches of contract, warranty, negligence, strict products liability, tort, violations of statutes or regulations, is restricted to the purchase price of the specific product covered by this warranty, as indicated on the original invoice.

If defective film needs replacement, the warranty coverage duration will not be extended. Phantom Film Ph retains the right to approve the warranty repair service provider for the warranty claim service. Payments for warranty claims will be directed to the authorized warranty repair service provider in accordance with the terms of this warranty.

Any statements, whether oral or written, made by parties other than those specified in this warranty should not be relied upon, as they are not considered part of this warranty. No individual or entity, including the dealer, possesses the authority or capability to alter or extend this warranty.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY CAN ONLY BE MODIFIED BY A WRITTEN AGREEMENT SIGNED BY AN OFFICER OF PHANTOM FILM PH.

1.7 Customer And Dealer Please Note:

To be eligible for warranty claims in the future, the dealer (and customer) must complete the warranty card and online registration at the time of Product installation. Legible and fully informative warranties are essential, as unclear or incomplete ones may cause delays or denials in processing claims. 1.8 To Make a Warranty Claim:

Phantom Film Ph reserves the right to verify eligibility for this warranty coverage, and to inspect the affected window before approving a claim. To make a warranty service claim, it is required that the following steps be followed:

1. To initiate a warranty service claim, contact your original installing dealer. If your dealer is unavailable, visit Phantom Film Ph website at https://phantomfilmph.com/authorized_distributor.php to find the nearest Phantom Film Ph installer.
2. To process a warranty claim, a Phantom Film Ph dealer must receive the required warranty claim support materials. (Details on specific materials may be provided elsewhere in the document.)
 - A. Phantom film Ph Warranty Card.
 - B. proof of purchase from the installing dealer. It is recommended to retain a copy of your proof of purchase for this purpose.
3. After the warranty repair service is finished, the customer must sign a warranty repair claim form. This form allows the dealer to receive reimbursement for the provided warranty repair service.
4. All payments for warranty claims will be directed to the warranty repair service provider who has received approval. In advance by Phantom Film Ph to perform the warranty service pursuant to the terms of this warranty.
